


Dear Family,





Please do NOT eat or drink anything after midnight before your surgery. After your surgery, you will wake up and have all kinds of juices and popsicles to drink and eat.




Before Surgery


You will get to wear a special bracelet with your name on it. This helps the doctors & nurses get to know you.

Bring your favorite TOY or Blanket with you!






Why are you having surgery?


Who Are All The Funny Looking People?

Your family will be in the waiting room, which is very close by. They will be by your side when you wake up. They will all be very proud of you for doing so good!


WAKE UP SLEEPYHEAD!!! ©
